# **AUDITIONS for REGISTERED students**

Students will be able to audition for named roles ahead of our summer program at Open Window Theatre Sunday, May 7 (2:00-4:00 PM).

A PARTICIPANT MUST BE COMPLETELY REGISTERED, INCLUDYING PAYMENT, IN ORDER TO AUDITION.

Students may not be required to attend the entire audition time. Materials and details will be sent to students closer to the May 7 date. Any students joining after cast list is sent will be added to the ensemble.

#### Students DO NOT need to audition to be in the show or to receive an ensemble or small role.

\*\*Students in the current spring semester YAA classes may audition before or after class and do not need to sign up for an audition spot. If the above date does not work for your schedule, a student may send in a recording or schedule an outside audition : youth@openwindowtheatre.org

<u>Students may not be called to every rehearsal</u>. But everyone will be called to rehearsals for tech week starting August 14th, and must attend all performances for their cast. A cast list and further break down of rehearsal schedule will be sent by June 1<sup>st</sup>.

# **EXPECTATIONS**

Putting on a musical is a combined effort between administration, staff, crew, volunteers, parents, and actors/participants. In order to create a positive experience and environment, make a show that is truly collaborative while also being challenging, educational, and of high quality, it is imperative that the following expectations be observed.

- 1. **Be prepared.** Participants are asked to bring a water bottle, pencil, and script to every rehearsal. Scripts will be sent home for participants to spend time at home memorizing lines, practicing their singing, and running choreography.
- 2. **Be kind.** There is a large range of ages, abilities, and experiences of participants. Everybody is welcome, whether this is their first or 1,459th time on stage!
- 3. Every role and every participant is important. There are a few named roles and a large ensemble in our show. Some sung and spoken lines that are under a named character may be redistributed to ensemble members. We ask that all participants be gracious in sharing roles or accepting solos. Every participant and character is fundamental to a successful production!
- 4. **Costumes.** Students may be asked to provide some basic pieces for costumes. Details will be communicated at a later date, but no participant is expected to purchase anything not found at home.
- 5. Attendance. August 14, August 15, and August 16 Rehearsals are MANDATORY.

Participants MUST also attend all performances for their cast *Every* participant is essential to the performance!

6. **HAVE FUN.** This musical is meant to be both a fun experience and a quality show. Let's work and have fun together!
